City of Cloverdale City Council Resolution No. 016-2012

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CLOVERDALE APPROVING MAXIMUM ALLOWABLE SOLID WASTE, COMPOSTING AND RECYCLING RATES AND REPEALING RATE SCHEDULES ADOPTED UNDER RESOLUTION NO. 047-2009

WHEREAS, in May of 2007, USA Waste informed the City of its intent to sell its holdings in Sonoma County to the Ratto Group of Companies, Inc., including its interest in the Franchise Agreement for Garbage and Rubbish Disposal with the City of Cloverdale; and

WHEREAS, the City Council consented to the assignment of the Franchise Agreement effective January 1, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into a First Amendment to Agreement for Garbage and Rubbish Disposal ("First Amendment") with the Ratto Group and its subsidiary Redwood Empire Disposal, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the First Amendment, the rate structure that was in place at the time of the assignment from USA Waste was to remain in effect until June 30, 2008; and

WHEREAS, the rate structure in place at the time of the assignment was the rate structure adopted by Resolution No. 65-2006; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 96-2008, the City Council authorized effective August 1, 2008 rate increases of 7.22% residential and 10.21% commercial, which included the rate increases previously approved in Resolution No. 65-2006 in addition to rate increases of 2.21% based on CPI and tipping fees as permitted in the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on July 22, 2009, in addition to the rate increases authorized by Resolution No. 65-2006, at the request of Redwood Empire Disposal, Inc. the City Council approved Resolution No. 047-2009 authorizing rate increases of 4.78% for residential and commercial customers based on CPI and tipping fees as permitted in the Franchise Agreement; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2011, the City Council adopted Ordinance No. 677-2011 repealing Cloverdale Municipal Code Chapter 8.12, and adding a new Chapter 8.12, entitled, "Collection, Disposal and Processing of Solid Waste Recyclables and Compostable Materials and Related Activities" to the Cloverdale Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2011, the City Council approved Resolution No. 021-2011 adopting a new franchise agreement with Redwood Empire Disposal Inc. that, among other things, established a new franchise term provided for amendment of franchise rates, and provided for new services to be provided by RED to the City and to its residents; and

WHEREAS, the maximum allowable rates remained unchanged in the new franchise agreement pending an analysis of rates of solid waste, composting and recycling; and

WHEREAS, the franchise included an increase to 12% from 9% of the franchise fee payable by RED to the City, of which 11% was allowed to be recoverable by franchise service charges; and

WHEREAS, implementation of two percent of the franchise fee was to take place once the analysis of maximum allowable rates was conducted; and

WHEREAS, the analysis is still in process and the City desires to implement the final two percent of the franchise fees, with any other approved adjustments to take place once the analysis is complete; and

WHEREAS, on February 23, 2012, the Finance & Administration Subcommittee reviewed and recommended approval of the maximum allowable rate structure proposed by Redwood Empire Disposal, Inc.; and

WHEREAS, on March 14, 2012, the City Council reviewed the maximum allowable rate structure and directed staff to schedule a public hearing to consider the revised structure; and

WHEREAS, The proposed rate structure is consistent with the Franchise Agreement and will provide Redwood Empire Disposal with a fair rate of return.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Cloverdale as follows:

- 1. The above recitals are true and correct and are hereby incorporated into this resolution as findings of the Cloverdale City Council.
- 2. The City Council of the City of Cloverdale approves the rate schedule shown in **Exhibit A** attached hereto, to be effective June 1, 2012.
 - 3. Resolution No. 047-2009 is hereby repealed.
